

| Protective box (69) .....        | unbolt, bolt on (installation position of fuel pump,<br>see 07.3-5713). |
| Rubber pads (58) from tabs ..... | detach, examine, replace if necessary, attach.                          |

### Model 124 T-model




Pay attention to safety precautions!

| Pressure in fuel tank ..... | release by opening fuel filler cap, closing. |
|-----------------------------|--|

Cover (69a) . . . . .	detach, attach (installation position of fuel pump, see Note).
Fuel hose at delivery end (52) and fuel hose at suction end (53) . . . . .	pinch off with clamp (011), take off (pay attention to Note). Special tool 000 589 40 37 00.
Fuel hose at suction end (53) . . . . .	detach, fit on. To do this, slacken hose clip (53/3), tighten.
Rubber pads (58a) from tabs . . . . .	detach, attach. Detach rubber pad (58a) from fuel pump 1 (M3m1), examine, replace if necessary, fit on.
Leaktightness of all connection points . . . . .	check with engine running.

#### **Note**

##### **Model 124 T-model**

Fuel pump 1 (M3m1) is located between rear axle and fuel tank.

Do not pinch off fuel hose at suction end at the bend (arrow).
