Work Instructions #263 and 264 describe the detailed procedure for installing a Mercedes-Benz integrated cellular telephone system in any vehicle as of M.Y. 1992.

Note:

With the introduction of model year production startup, all M.Y. 1992 vehicles are prewired for cellular telephones. Models 129.076 (600SL), 140.057 (600SEL) and 140.076 (600SEC) are pre-equipped with a cellular telephone from the VPC and merely require NAM Programming.

On MY 1992 vehicles up to the chassis end numbers listed in the table below, the tri-band antenna was not installed in production.

Subsequent installation of the tri-band antenna should **only** be performed when a customer requests installation of an MB integrated cellular telephone.

Work Instruction #266 describes the procedure for retrofitting a tri-band antenna (AM/FM/Cellular).
